

Dear Prayer Teammates,

So many of you have faithfully prayed for us and the Khmer of Chhlong, Cambodia. God has answered so many of those prayers in miraculous and merciful ways that were beyond our thoughts or plans. Sonya and I are getting old. We are grandparents now :-) and we have forgotten many of those answered prayers. If you have collected our Krammbodian Prayer updates through the past 12 years, could you help us by letting us know. We would like to get a copy of them all to read back through and be reminded of God's faithfulness.



Three prayer requests to ask you to uphold:

1. Family - Our new grandbaby, Gabriel Brantham Kramm, is amazingly beautiful and we are floored at how fun and easy it is to be grandparents :-) Matt and Stephanie are doing a great job raising him. Please pray for their parental wisdom as well as for Gabriel to know God and his power and hope in his life(Eph. 1:17-19). Zech(20) has just finished his studies and work commitment at Joshua Institute in CA. He will be coming to stay with us for a month or two and is seeking what God has for him next. Nate(16) is in school with his cousins in NC for this semester and will be with us for the holidays and re-join us in January after exams. Mark(14) is with Sonya and I as we cruz the highways of America visiting various churches, friends and family.

We are all freezing but are getting used to winter weather again. Burrrr!

2. Lok Krew Jon and his wife Narun - In last month's update we told you about the village of Break Go, how many have been baptized there recently, and how Lok Krew Jon (local school vice principal) and Narun are going from house to house, each night, praying and worshiping Jesus with any who invite them in. Just before we left Cambodia, the leader of the local Buddhist Temple used the loud speaker system, that is heard in the entire village, to boycott them. He stated that they were doing illegal things and must stop immediately. He also stated that he was going to sue them and he warned all the villagers not to allow them into their homes. We encouraged Lok Krew Jon and Narun and prayed much for God's will to be done. At first they were very fearful of these accusations, but took great courage in Acts 4:18-20 and Matthew 5:11-12.

This couple has also been used by God to help open up a new village, named Dong Hut, to the gospel and an entire family has come to faith there. Pray for this couple as God leads you. Pictured below:



3. Krew Moy - You may recall our asking prayer often for Krew Moy. He faced the above kind of persecution over a year ago, and decided that he would stop sharing his faith because of it. That lasted about 2 months, but God's Spirit was stronger than his resolve and in the end Krew Moy decided that he would take the persecution as from the Lord. This decision has brought much joy as in the last few months his wife, 4 of his children, a couple of siblings, and his step mother have come to Christ. He has faithfully prayed and shared the truth and love of Christ with all these

people. Recently, Moy has begun to share the gospel in the many villages where his police work takes him. Pray that the Holy Spirit will convict and draw many people in these unreached villages to repentance and faith in Jesus.
