Developing the Property

It's hard to believe that we've been back in Uganda for over a year since our furlough ended. Much has taken place during that time. We came back to an empty plot we'd purchased before furlough. Since coming back, we've been able to build a place for us to live at the back of the plot. We've erected our tent and moved the church to the land. Also, on April 11, we broke ground for a permanent church building, which will contain the auditorium, several classrooms, and dormitory rooms for institute classes. We are building only as God provides the resources. Thanks to everyone who has helped us so far.

Spreading the Gospel

In spite of the dry weather conditions that have lingered around us, we continue to see a harvest of souls for the Lord. One of these is Jennifer, a young lady Sara hired to help her in the house. She was saved in January, and she is excited about Bible studies. She was baptized at our baptismal service on Easter Sunday.

One lady who was saved and never had a chance to be baptized was Lily Grace. Lily Grace had come to services several times and had gotten saved, but she knew she had AIDS. Complications from AIDS claimed her life. I was able to preach the gospel at her funeral in Kitgum. Lily Grace left behind four kids, two of whom also have AIDS. Please pray for these orphans.

Also, I was invited to preach the gospel in Pabbo, which used to be the largest refugee camp during the war years. Now many are still living there, hungry to hear the truth. We'd heard there were many deaf people in Pabbo, so I took along Francis, who translates for the deaf people who come to church in Gulu. Over the last few months, several dozen people have been saved in Pabbo, deaf and hearing alike. Please pray for this outreach. We're organizing to have many of these baptized in the near future.

Waiting for Baby

Many of you already know that Sara is due with our fifth child on June 29. Please pray for her and the baby. Before we head to Kampala for the baby's birth sometime around the middle of June, we'd like to finish our home schooling year with Andrew and Joseph. Please pray that we'll be able to do this and that both boys will finish well, before the baby arrives.
